Indicative Funding Budgets:

The total Indicative Budgets for this call: 138,730,166 €. This comprises the following ARTEMIS-JU funding and National funding from the ARTEMIS Member States:

<u>ARTEMIS Joint Undertaking contribution</u>: 49,226,833 €

<u>ARTEMIS Member States contribution (in M€)</u>: 89,503,333 €

The ARTEMIS Annual Work Plan for 2012 (please refer to the documentation package) calls for two types of projects: ARTEMIS Sub-Programme projects (ASPs, similar to previous Calls, described in Part A of the AWP 2012) and ARTEMIS Innovation Pilot Projects (AIPPs, described in Part B of the AWP). ARTEMIS Member States can provide budgets specifically for ASPs, specifically for AIPPs or a budget that can be allocated to either type of project. Please study the information in the Call documentation and read the AWP 2012 carefully when deciding which type of project is the most appropriate for your submission.

N.B.:

- The commitment of Austria, Italy and Spain is subject to final approval by the respective National Financial Authorities;
- The commitment Portugal was not communicated by the time of Call publication.
- Belgium (Flanders): an increase and/or a split of budget between part A and part B might occur in May 2012. Further information will be provided as "latest news" in the Participant Portal.

In some ARTEMIS Member States, commitment to Part B of the AWP 2012 is limited to:

- Austria: AIPP 1 and AIPP4
- Germany: AIPP 1, 3 and 4 (4: only for production)
- Italy: AIPP 1, 4 and 6

Eligibility criteria: The eligibility criteria for Full Project Proposals and the eligibility criteria to receive funding from the ARTEMIS JU and from ARTEMIS Member States are specified in the document set (see the "**Guide for Applicants**" and "**Eligibility Criteria and Funding Rates**" documents).

Objectives: Please see the Annual Work Programme 2012.

Indicative timetable:

- The ARTEMIS Joint Undertaking intends to provide feedback to the proposers with an Evaluation Summary Report by end of October 2012.
- It is expected that the selection of Full Project Proposals for funding will take place in November 2012.
- It is expected that the grant agreement negotiations for the selected proposals will start in December 2012.

Project agreements: Participants in any project resulting from this call are required to conclude amongst themselves a project agreement. This project agreement shall lay down the intellectual property arrangements in compliance with Article 23 of the Statutes annexed to Council Regulation 74/2008 of 20 December 2007 on the establishment of the ARTEMIS Joint Undertaking.
